SoundPoint® IP 501 Start Up

The SoundPoint® IP 501 telephone starts up as soon as power is applied. Several verification steps follow (depending on how the telephone has been configured by your System Administrator):

1. Obtain network settings (DHCP, SNTP, etc.).
2. Load Configurable Applications and Services.
3. Load main software.
